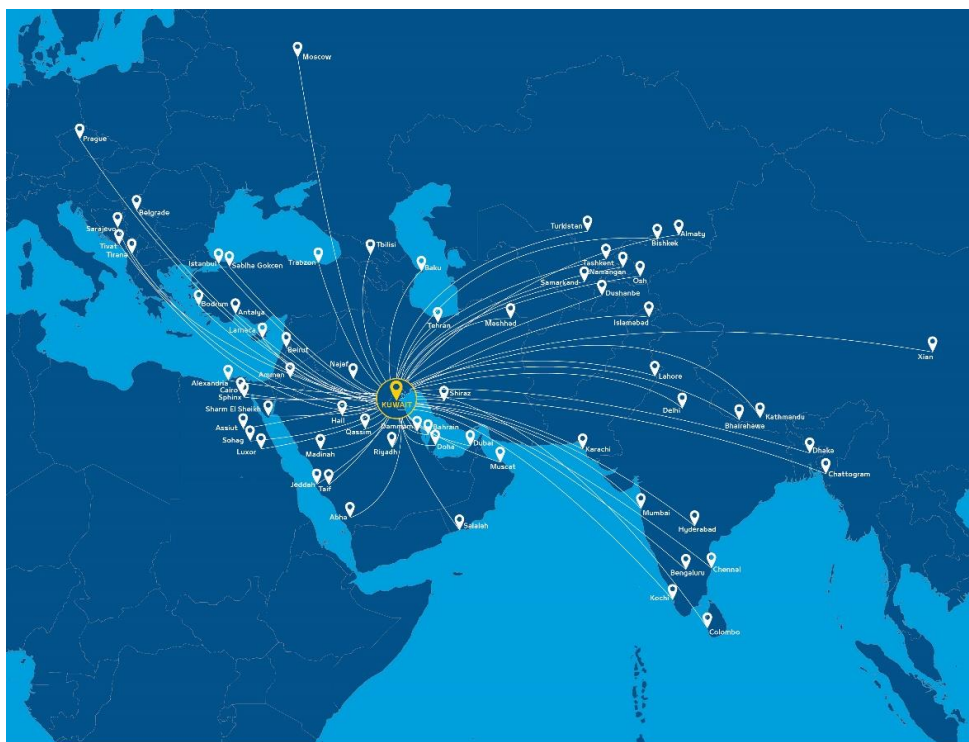

ROHIT RAMACHANDRAN

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Rohit Ramachandran is credited with turning Jazeera Airways around, and putting it on the path to profitable growth. He has been with the airline for the last six years as Chief Executive Officer where he led an ambitious program of restructuring the company, dramatically reducing the cost structure, renegotiating major costs (including aircraft leases), network expansion, fleet renewal, significant increases in seat factor and yield, while maintaining a close focus on P&L.

Under his leadership, the airline has posted consistently rising profits. Despite the pandemic in 2020, the airline returned to profitability in 2021 with \$23.4m net profit on operating revenues of \$265.3m. In 2022, the company achieved record profitability of \$65.7m with operating revenues of \$595.4m for the same year. During this period, the fleet has increased from seven to 23 aircraft, and the market cap of the company has grown by a multiple of 7.

With over twenty years of aviation experience, Rohit has worked with four major airlines on three continents. Previously, he was a member of the start-up team at Air Arabia, the Middle East's first and largest low cost airline. From analyst in Air Arabia's commercial division, Rohit rose through the ranks to serve as General Manager – India, Regional General Manager – South Asia, Head of Marketing, Head of Business Development, and Chief Operating Officer of the first Air Arabia subsidiary airline – Air Arabia Maroc. Rohit is in the unique position of having experience across full-service airlines, including Singapore Airlines and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, as well as hybrid & low-cost carriers. He was recently featured in Forbes Middle East's "Top Travel and Tourism Leaders in the Middle East 2023".

Rohit has an MBA in International Marketing from the University of Leicester UK, Change Management from IMD Switzerland, and Aviation Law from Cranfield University UK. In 2020, Rohit was elected as Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society (FRAeS), the world oldest professional body dedicated to Aerospace and Aviation, founded in 1866.
